COLLEGE GENERAL RULES

1. The spirit of life in the college must be unity, mutual trust and co-operation among the students, staff and management.
2. Students shall behave well-disciplined in and outside the campus.
3. Every student must make it a point of his / her personal duty to attend the class daily and punctually. They are expected to be in the class at the first bell and wait for the teacher.
4. No student shall leave a class without the permission of the lecturer or until the class is dismissed.
5. Rise from your seat and remain standing until a teacher or a guest takes his seat or ask you to take your seat when he/she enters your class.
6. When teachers are forced to take leave and absent, students should remain in the class and do the work assigned to them for the period or go to the general library. No student should be seen outside the class room during class hours.
7. Students are not allowed to see visitors during the class hours. The students or those residing in hostels are not allowed to see their visitors in the college. Letters addressed to the college will not be delivered to the students. They will have their letters and communications addressed to their homes.
8. No matter of publication in the Newspaper, Magazine, Journals or Notice may be submitted in the name of the college without the permission of the Principal.
10. No meeting and organizational activities shall be held in the College building or anywhere in the college premises without the prior permission of the Principal. No collection should be taken without prior permission
11. Megaphone, Loudspeakers, Radio Camera etc. should not be used and notices, posters, banners or board shall not be displayed or distributed in the campus without permission.
12. Bringing & using of mobile phone, Lap, Tab etc. with out permission in the campus is strictly prohibited.

13. Vehicles are not permitted in the campus. Students who bring vehicles with special permission should keep the vehicles in the parking area.
14. Loss or damage caused to building, furniture, tools and apparatus of the college due to violent action of students will be made good by imposing collective fine on all the students of the college.
15. Keep the College furniture and other equipment of the college neat and in the serviceable condition. Do not disfigure wall or furniture with any writing and engraving. Any loss or destruction to college properties will be chargeable individually or collectively as the case may be.
16. Students shall always carry identity cards with them and wear uniform

Incidents of Ragging or any such indecent behaviour of any student to the fellow student involving physical or mental assault should be treated as a criminal offence, punishable under the provision of the Criminal procedure code. Students are strictly warned that there would be no warning in this matter and Court / University directions will be followed. Students shall not take part in activities against the authorities of the college.

19. Attendance Shall be Marked at the beginning of each period.
20. Students who desires to be admitted in the hostel should obey the rules of the hostel
21. First year students should remit all the fee at the time of admission and senior students, on or before the 10 th working day of the semester. Tuition fee with a fine of Rs.50 upto 15 th working day and with superfine of Rs 100 upto 20 th working day of the semester.If the fee and fine are not remitted within the allotted date, the name of the student will be removed from the roll of the college.
