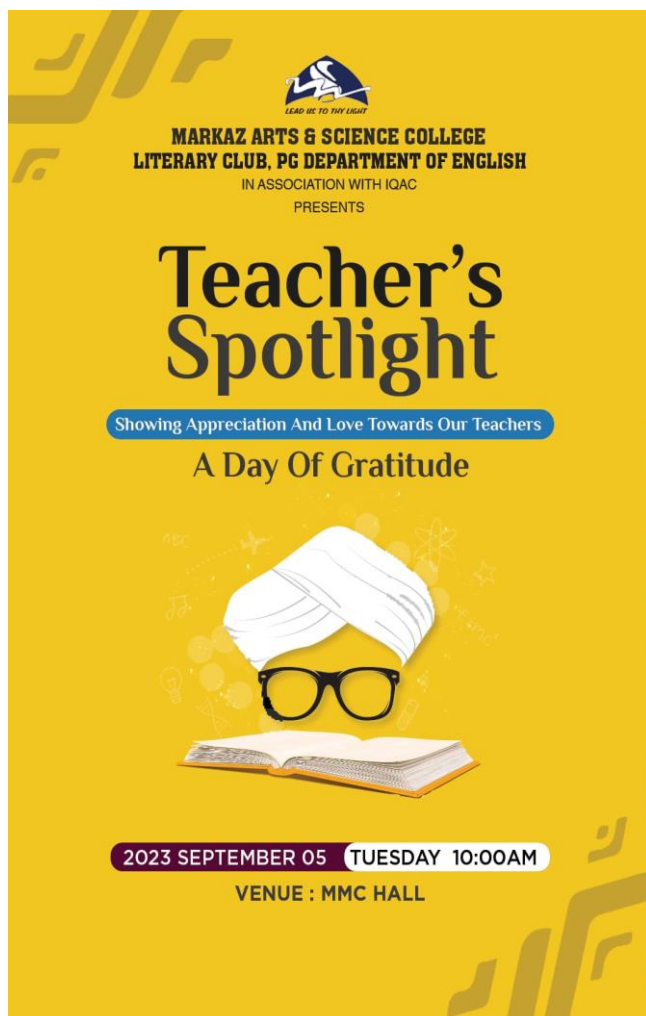


TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATION 2023
